- ~ The Fredericksburg City Democratic Committee (FCDC) meeting was called to order by Tres Seaver, Chair.
- ~ The secretary submitted the minutes for the 03/11/06 Fredericksburg City Democratic Committee meeting.
 - Motion was made to adopt the minutes. Motion passed.
- ~ The Treasurer reported on the current financial state of the FCDC and submitted a Balance Sheet, Profit and Loss Statement, and Check Register Statement covering 1/01/06 to 4/07/06.
 - Motion was made to adopt the Treasurer's Report. Motion passed.
- ~ The Chair reported on the following:
 - The finalization of credentials committee for the Caucus for the First Congressional District Nominating Convention at Noon today.
 - The CD1 Nominating Convention will be held at the Holiday Inn, Crown Plaza, Williamsburg, 13 May, 1:00 - 5:00 PM.
 - The State Party of Virginia (SPVA) will offer a training presentation to anyone interested at 9:00 AM that morning.
 - Unity Dinner will follow for those interested in attending.
 - The Regional Breakfast meeting time has changed to 9:00 AM.
 - PREVAIL access fee of \$200 was waved by the SPVA because we added new Dem voter ID's last year.
 - There is still a need to sign contract, order form to get updated account ID / password.
 - All eight City Council Candidates confirmed their intent to attend this morning's meeting to present their views.
 - UMW YD's have been contacted via Lela Graham and we are awaiting their response.

Old Business

New Business

- ~ A decision not to cancel the May 13th meeting was made with the CD1 Nominating Convention being held the same day.
