 - Motion was made to adopt the Treasurer's Report. Motion passed.

 - Shawn O'Donnell has confirmed that he will Attend and could help get a "big" speaker to participate.

New Business

- ~ The need for signs and stickers for O'Donnell & Webb was addressed. Ron Smith volunteered to coordinate the effort and make the trip to Richmond to gather Webb material.
- ~ Voter ID / GOTV effort was discussed. Ron Smith will chair the VRE stand, as he did last election, and coordinate any volunteers who can help during the week leading up to the election, starting on the 30th of September.
