- ~ The Fredericksburg City Democratic Committee (FDC) meeting was called to order by Tres Seaver, Chair.
- ~ The Treasurer's report was set aside until the next meeting.
- ~ The Secretary submitted copies of the Minutes for the last meeting 3/10/07. Motion was made to adopt the Minutes. Motion passed.

Old Business

- ~ Carlos campaign was reported as going well.
- ~ At this time, we are still looking for House candidate to run against Howell.
 - The party has until June 9th to put a candidate on the ballot.

New Business

- ~ A DPVA (Democratic Party of Virginia) round-table discussion will be held on the 5th of May for which 3 FDC members will be in attendance.
 - The meeting will be followed by a PREVAIL 2 /Van training session at 2:30 PM which is open to all who would like to attend.
- ~ DPVA has requested a status report from all committees via an informal poll of how the committees are doing.
 - The Chair discussed the efforts of the FDC over the past few months and expressed the opinion that we are not doing enough.
 - Some members pointed out that members on the subcommittees to find candidates have put forth a great amount of time and effort over the past few months to field the election. These efforts often go unrecognized as they are done in the subcommittees.
 - All members agreed that the current state of the FDC is much improved over the past two years, but, we also see many areas that need improvement.
- ~ The committee agreed to take a survey within the committee members to determine if a different meeting time would better serve the majority of members and to see if there are other issues and projects that the membership would like to address and participate in.
